**Applicability.** The interests of National and State Security require that all persons being considered for enlistment, appointment or retention in the Ohio Military Reserve be reliable, trustworthy, of good character, of complete and unswerving loyalty to the United States.

**Supplementation.** Supplementation of this regulation and establishment of command and local policies and forms are prohibited without prior written approval from the Assistant Chief of Staff, Intelligence and Security, OHMR-G2.

**Suggested Improvements.** Suggested improvements which may be considered for this regulation should be forwarded in writing to the proponent agency of this regulation, the Office of the Assistant Chief of Staff, Intelligence and Security, OHMR-G2, Camp Perry Training Site, 1000 Lawrence Avenue, Port Clinton, Ohio, 43452-9578.

**Summary.** This Regulation prescribes procedures whereby disloyal or subversive Ohio Military Reserve personnel will be discharged and disloyal or subversive persons applying for enlistment or appointment will be rejected.

**Supersedes.** This regulation supersedes OHMR-R 380-1, 12 September 1984.

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**Section 1**  
Personnel

1-1. The following items of information would raise security implications requiring determinations as to whether enlistment, appointment or retention of an individual is clearly consistent with the interests of National and State Security. This list is not all inclusive or all exclusive.

a. Commission of any act of sabotage, espionage, or sedition, or attempts thereat or preparation therefor; or conspiring with, or aiding or abetting another to commit any act of sabotage, espionage, treason or sedition.

b. Establishing or continuing a sympathetic association with a saboteur, spy, traitor, seditionist, anarchist, or revolutionist, or with an espionage or other secret agent of representative of a foreign nation, or any representative of a foreign nation whose interests may be adverse to the interest of the

United States, or with any person who advocates the use of force or illegal activity or violence to overthrow the Government of the United States

or the State of Ohio, or the alteration of the form of government of the United States or the State of Ohio by unconstitutional means.

c. Advocacy of use of force or illegal activity or violence to overthrow the Government of the United States or the State of Ohio or the alteration of the form of government by unconstitutional means.

d. Membership in, or affiliation or sympathetic association with any foreign or domestic organization, movement, group, or combination of persons which is totalitarian, Fascist, Communist, or subversive; or which has adopted or shows a policy of advocating or approving the commission of acts of force or violence to deny other persons their rights under the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the State of Ohio, or which seeks

to alter the form of government of the United States by unconstitutional means.

e. Intentional, unauthorized disclosure to any person of security information, or of other information disclosure which is prohibited by law.

f. Performing or attempting to perform his duties, or otherwise acting, so as to serve the interests of another government in preference to the interests of the United States or the State of Ohio.

g. Participation in the activities of any organization established as a front for an organization referred to on paragraph d. above when his personal views were sympathetic to the subversive purpose of such organization.

h. Participation in the activities of any organization with knowledge that it had been infiltrated by members of subversive groups under circumstances indicating that the individual was a part of or sympathetic to its purposes.

i. Sympathetic interest in totalitarian, Fascist, Communist, or similar subversive movements.

j. Any behavior, activities, or associations which tend to show that the individual is not reliable or trustworthy.

k. Any facts which furnish reason to believe that the individual may be subjected to coercion, influence, or pressure which may cause him to act contrary to the best interests of the National or State Security.

l. Participation in the activities of an organization referred to on d. above, in a capacity where he should reasonably have had knowledge of the subversive aims or purposes of the organization.

m. Sympathetic association with a member or members of an organization referred to in d. above. This will not ordinarily include chance or occasional meetings, nor contacts limited to normal business or official relations.

n. Currently maintaining a close, continuing association with a person who engaged in activities or associations of the type referred to in a. through i. above. A close, continuing association may be deemed to exist if the individual lives at the same premises as, frequently visits, or frequently communicates with such person.

o. Close, continuing association with the type described in n. above, even though later separated by distance, if the circumstances indicate that renewal of the association is probable.

p. The presence of a spouse, parent, brother, sister or offspring in a nation whose interests may be adverse to the interests of the United States, or in satellites or occupied areas of such a nation, under circumstances permitting coercion or pressure to be brought on the individual through such relatives.

q. Willful violation or disregard of security regulations.

r. Acts of recklessness, irresponsible, or wanton nature which indicate such poor judgment and instability as to suggest that the individual might disclose security information to unauthorized persons or otherwise assist such persons, whether deliberately or inadvertently, in activities adverse to the security of the United States or the State of Ohio.

s. Refusal by the individual, upon grounds of constitutional privilege against self incrimination, to testify before a Congressional Committee regarding charges of his alleged disloyalty or other misconduct (Executive Order 10491, 14 Oct 53).

t. Failure to sign a loyalty certificate, such as DA Form 1111 (Certificate of Nonaffiliation with Certain Organizations), or DD Form 98 (Armed Forces Security Questionnaire), or OHMR Form 13/E (Oath of Enlistment) or OHMR Form 13/O (Oath of Office); pleading protection of the Fifth Amendment or of Article 31, Ohio or Uniform Code of Military Justice, in refusing to completely answer questions contained in required security forms, personal history statements and other official documents; pleading protection of the Fifth Amendment or of Article 31 of the Ohio or Uniform Code of Military Justice, or otherwise failing to answer any pertinent questions propounded in the course of an official investigation, interrogation, hearing, or examination conducted for the purpose of ascertaining the existence of extent, or both, of conduct of the nature described in a. through s. above.

## **Section 2** Enlistment/Appointment

2-1. Each applicant for enlistment or appointment will be required to read this regulation.

2-2. The following entry will be made in the "Remarks" section of OHMR Form 11 or OHMR Form 21, whichever is applicable:

"I have read OHMR-R 380-1, 01 Sep 98, and certify that I have never engaged in

disloyal or subversive activities as defined therein.”

2-3. The applicant will sign his full name immediately following the above certificate. Any person who cannot or will not subscribe to the certificate indicated above will be rejected for service in the Ohio Military Reserve.
