Supersedes. This regulation supersedes OHMR-R 614-1, 01 January 1986

Applicability. This regulation applies to all components, elements, detachments, units and personnel of the Ohio Military Reserve.

Supplementation. Supplementation of this regulation at any level is strictly prohibited.

Improvements. Suggested improvements which may be considered for this regulation should be forwarded in writing to the proponent agency of this regulation, the Office of the Assistant Chief of Staff, Personnel and Administration, OHMR-G1, Camp Perry Training Site, 1000 Lawrence Avenue, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452-9578.

Summary. This Regulation establishes guidelines for requesting the assignment of relief of all unit commanders in the Ohio Military Reserve.

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1. General. This regulation establishes policies and procedures to be followed when requesting a change in unit commanders.

2. Reference. AR 600-100

3. Responsibilities. Commanders of brigades and battalions are responsible for compliance with this regulation. They will take action as follows:

a. Brigade commanders will forward requests for relief or assignment of battalion commanders to HQOHMR for approval of the Corps Commander and appropriate action.

b. Battalion commanders will forward all requests for relief or assignment of company commanders to brigade headquarters for approval of the brigade commander and appropriate action.

4. Request for assignment or relief.

a. All requests for the relief or assignment of any unit commander be submitted, by memorandum, through the appropriate channels to the appropriate level.

b. Any memorandum received without the proper endorsements will be returned with no action taken.
