**Summary.** This Regulation sets forth policy and guidelines of the OHMR for mandatory retirement of all officer and enlisted personnel.

**Supersedes.** This regulation supersedes OHMR-R 635-1, 01 January 1986 and OHMR-R 635-1, 01 September 1998.

**Applicability.** This regulation applies to all personnel of the Ohio Military Reserve.

**Supplementation.** Supplementation of this regulation and establishment of command and local policies is strictly prohibited.

**Suggested Improvements.** Suggested improvements which may be considered for this regulation should be forwarded in writing to the proponent agency of this regulation, the Office of the Assistant Chief of Staff, Personnel and Administration, OHMR-G1, Camp Perry Training Site, 1000 Lawrence Avenue, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452-9578.

1. Purpose. This regulation sets forth policies and procedures for the mandatory retirement of members of the OHMR.

2. Authority for Action.

a. The authority for the mandatory retirement of all OHMR personnel is Section 5923.03 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

b. Age 67 is the mandatory retirement age under paragraph a. above.

c. This age limit will be enforced regardless of the desire of the individual concerned or the needs of the OHMR.

d. Individuals will retire at the end of the training year (01 Oct - 30 Sep) in which they reach their 67<sup>th</sup> birthday.

3. Announcement of Retirement. The retirement of an individual will be announced in orders issued by HQOHMR.

4. Ceremonies. Retiring members will be recognized in appropriate ceremonies during training in the training year in which they attain retirement age.
