SUBJECT: MP Duty Equipment SOP 700.10

1. REFERENCE

None

2. GENERAL

This SOP defines MP Duty Equipment and the standards for its wear.

3. PURPOSE

The purpose of this SOP is to provide uniform standards, definitions and policies regarding the wear of MP related equipment.

4. SCOPE

This SOP is applicable to all personnel under the command and control of the Commander, Ohio Military Reserve, and all personnel entering any area under the control and jurisdiction of the same.

5. RESPONSIBILITY

It is the responsibility of all commanders and NCOs to see that these standards are applied uniformly.

6. DEFINITIONS

a) "MP Duty Equipment" is defined as any or all of the following items:

MP helmet liner	MP club	whistle
MP white hat	MP leather gear	hand irons
MP arm brassard	MP scarf	MP badge

b) "On MP duty" time is defined as time during which the individual is actively charged with the enforcement of law and order, regardless if that time is training time or SAD time. An individual may be "on duty" but not necessarily "on MP duty".


7. WEAR OF MP DUTY EQUIPMENT

a) MP duty equipment, either issued or privately owned, will be worn only while on MP duty or while traveling to or from such duty, provided that such duty will begin upon arrival or has ended upon departure.

b) While wearing MP duty equipment, or on MP duty, an individual will not smoke or eat unless taking an assigned break. At no time while on MP duty or wearing MP duty equipment will an individual consume alcoholic beverages or engage in undignified behavior of any type.

c) When taking assigned breaks while on MP duty or while wearing MP duty equipment, individuals must be aware of their image as an MP in the eyes of the public and other military

personnel. Breaks will be taken in an inconspicuous manner and place, maintaining a degree of professionalism at all times.
